How does the Lay Candidate Register?

Lay Candidate must have an online account with supreme.

Candidate Registration Process Is a Two Step Process

Step Two: Form 4 must be completed & sent to Master:

Master Instructions from Supreme: (12/13/2024)

- 1) Supreme provides Masters with registered list; Masters to work with FN to complete FORM 4
- 2) The Faithful Navigator for the assigned council will contact the candidate and assist him with **Form 4.**
- Due to the nature of this event, there's no requirement for an Assembly Admissions Committee approval.
- An email acknowledgement from the Council that a Knight is in good standing is sufficient rather than a wet signature.
- The DM can sign for the Council and Assembly.
- 3) Once completed, the Form 4 should be scanned and emailed to the District Master for review and approval.
- 4): The District Master's **deadline for submitting** all forms to the Supreme Master is **January 31**, 2025.
- 5): The Supreme Master will sign as Master following the Degree

 NOTE: Most important items on the form 4 are: the candidate's name, member number, and council.

Candidate Registration Process Is a Two Step Process

Step Two:

Registration for Priests and Seminarians

Priest and Seminarian Candidates need to create a supreme account BUT do not pay the registration fee. There should be a drop-down box for a "title." The title "Rev." should remove the fee. If a fee is paid in error, the fee will be returned by Supreme.

Priest and Seminarian Candidates MUST complete a Form 4.

Said Form 4 is then sent to the MASTER

Master will contact Supreme to ensure the registration of Priest/s or Seminarian/s.

From SM Michael McCusker:

We encourage the assemblies to cover the cost of their banquet tickets.

To facilitate the waiver of the exemplification fees our office will need to be notified with the name, membership number and council number of the priests and seminarians that are planning to attend the exemplification.

Next, I will need an email address for everyone sent to me. This will enable the Ceremonial Director and myself to notify those who will be working and provide them with info which they will need for that day.

Please let <u>everyone</u> know that they must register on Supreme's website if they are going to attend the banquet.



TRANSPORATION

Per Supreme FAQ:

Are there any arranged transportation accommodations for these events?

Attendees are responsible for arranging their travel plans to and from the event, including overnight accommodations

The 1st NJ District has arranged Special Ferry discount.

New York Waterways, in collaboration with FN, SK Vincent Lombardi, has arranged for a roundtrip ferry pass priced at \$9.75 per person. The ferry departs from Port Imperial, located at 4800 Avenue at Port Imperial, Weehawken, NJ 07086.

We recommend utilizing the <u>10:40 AM ferry to New York City and returning on or</u> before the 11:10 PM ferry.

Numerous parking garages are conveniently located in the vicinity and can be accessed on foot.

The ferry's weekend departure schedule from New Jersey and New York, as well as the shuttle's schedule and map can be found on 2nd NJ website as word Docs under heading "Exemplification."

TRANSPORATION

The 2nd NJ District has arranged NO special transportation.

It is up to each Assembly to arrange their own travel arrangements to NYC.

Consider teaming up with other Assemblies to rent a Charter Bus.

Just 4 wheels has 8 locations between Cape May and Lakewood. They rent a 15 passenger van and a 15 passenger jumbo van.

NJ Transit has a special web page for travel arrangements to NYC. These include Trains and Buses.

Train from Hamilton Station (NJ Transit operates a train from Hamilton to New York Penn Station every 30 minutes. Tickets cost \$12 - \$19 and the journey takes 1h 28m. Hamilton Station is just off Rt. 295 in the Trenton/ Lawrenceville area.





- 1) When is the event?
- The event will take place on Saturday, February 22, 2025, at St. Patrick's Cathedral in New York City, followed by a banquet at the New York Hilton Midtown. The schedule of events includes an Exemplification of the Fourth Degree followed by Sunday Vigil Mass and an Anniversary Banquet.
- 2) Who can attend the events?
- Any member who wishes to attend may order ticket(s). Third degree members desiring to take their Fourth Degree should select the "Candidate" option during registration. Current Fourth Degree members would select "Non-Candidate" to complete their registration.
- 3) Are the events open to the public?
- ► The exemplification and Mass at St. Patrick's are open to the public. No ticket is required. However, candidates must register and pay their exemplification fee (\$60 USD) no later than January 20, 2025. The banquet is not open to the public and you must purchase a ticket to attend, including guests.

- ▶ 4) I'm a member outside of the United States, am I eligible to attend?
- Yes, however, please note that all events will only be in English and the United States version of the degree will be exemplified.
- 5) How do I request tickets?
- ► Tickets can be ordered by visiting the <u>125th Anniversary Event site</u>. Members will need to create a unique login to reserve their tickets using their email address and creating a password. Members should **NOT** use their Officers Online username or password.
- 6) Is there a fee for tickets?
- ► FOR NON-CANDIDATES: The exemplification and Mass are free and do not require a ticket. FOR CANDIDATES TAKING THE DEGREE there is an Exemplification Fee of \$60.00 USD to cover administrative costs. Banquet tickets are \$125.00 USD. However, if a candidate purchases two banquet tickets, his exemplification fee will be waived
- > 7) Is there a limit to how many tickets I can reserve?
- Yes, a member may reserve a ticket for himself and up to five (5) additional guests (spouse, children, etc.) for a total of six (6) tickets.

- ▶ 8) Is there a deadline to reserve tickets?
- ► There is limited space both for the Exemplification and for the Banquet. Registration will close by January 20, 2025, unless tickets run out sooner.
- 9) How will I receive my tickets?
- ▶ Banquet tickets will be distributed at the New York Hilton, Midtown Hotel the day of the event. Upon arrival, banquet guests will check in at the reservation table and receive their tickets before entering. The only check in at the cathedral will be for Candidates taking their exemplification.
- ▶ 10) I have food allergies or need other special accommodations at the banquet? Are you tracking that?
- Yes, we will collect the name, food allergies and any special needs of a member or his guest at the time during online registration.

- ▶ 11) Are there any arranged transportation or overnight accommodations for these events?
- Attendees are responsible for arranging their travel plans to and from the event, including overnight accommodations if remaining in the New York City before or after the event.
- ▶ 12) Can I cancel tickets for a full refund?
- ▶ Yes, tickets can be canceled for a full refund by February 7, 2025.

Summary:

Candidates must register with and pay \$60 fee to Supreme by 01/20/2025.

Assembly must complete a Form 4 for EACH candidate and send them to the District Master by 01/31/2025.

Witnesses and other attendees to exemplification do NOT have to register with Supreme to attend the exemplification or Mass.

Anyone wishing to attend the Banquet Dinner MUST register and pay Supreme the \$125 per plate fee by 01/20/2025. Tickets will not be mailed but must be picked up at the dinner registration table. NO dinner tickets will be sold at the door!

Assemblies are to complete Form 4's and forward to Master. Transportation is not being provided by Supreme or District. Supreme has arranged special pricing at certain hotels.
